In our first 25 years, KDA has provided over \$3,000,000 for research into Kennedy's disease. This funding has supported global efforts to understand the mechanisms triggering the disease, to explore treatment pathways, and to establish the scientific basis for two ongoing clinical trials (AnnJi and Nido Biosciences). KDA funding has also supported the professional development of junior researchers, so important to continuing to advance the science until a cure can be found.

However, we still have miles to go to reach the point where there are effective therapies to treat KD. And farther still to find a cure. Scientific research is expensive, and we need to increase our fundraising to continue and accelerate ongoing research efforts. To do that, we need you help.

We're not asking for money. What we really need are your time and effort. As you may know, we recently formed a Fundraising Committee to help identify new sources of revenue. We currently have four volunteers for the committee; our goal is to enlist at least a dozen volunteers. Someone with fundraising experience would be a definite plus.
